

MINUTES OF THE JULY 21, 2009 SCIC MEETING

President Robert Hefta called the meeting to order.

Under Old Business, Richard Anten moved that the Minutes of the March 17, 2009 Meeting in Perry, GA be accepted as printed. Wanda Brady seconded the motion. The motion passed.

David Kessler made a motion that all non-internet members receive a hard black and white copy of the newsletter. Larry Faller seconded the motion. Motion passed.
